Emphasis is placed on patient selection, which is critical for optimum cosmetic and functional results. Further topics include psychological issues, patient

expectation, specific contraindications to reconstruction and chronic pain following surgery.

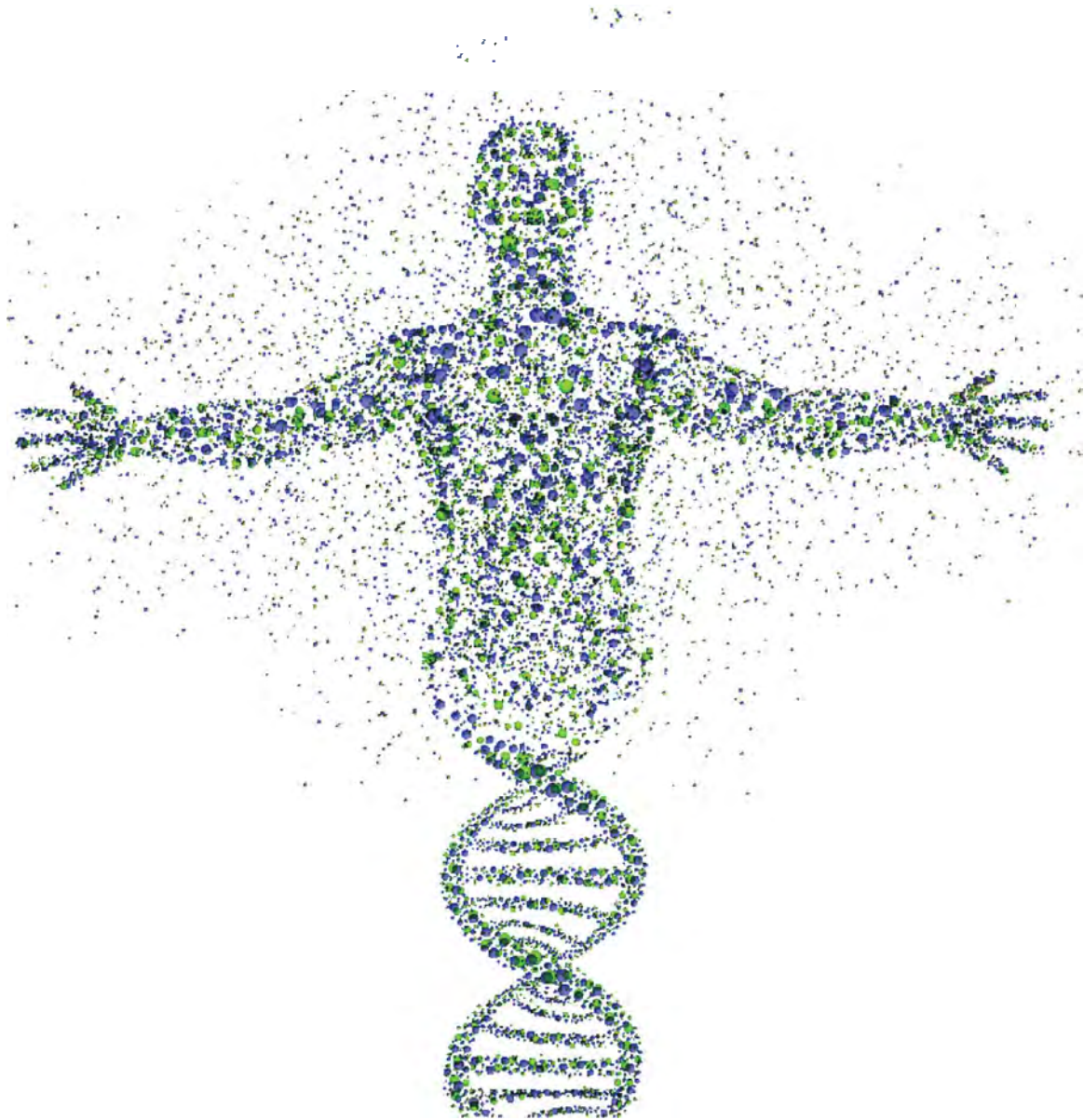
